



How Revenue is Generated & Paid

This document outlines, step-by-step, the process of how you, as a MedicationCard.org affiliate get paid, starting from the time the cards are presented at the pharmacy to the time you receive your check.

Step 1 – Cardholder presents your specially-coded card to a participating pharmacy. The pharmacy must input the info on the card, along with the appropriate customer information, into their system. Note: if a pharmacy doesn't do this, no claim will be generated in the system.

Step 2 – Input claims fall into one of two claim categories:

- Non-Withheld or Other Rx's: Claims where no additional discount was generated by using the card, for example, when someone presents a card when purchasing an already-discounted drug (like Walmart's \$4 & \$10 price list), or the profit margin for the pharmacy is not adequate enough to. **We do NOT get paid on these claims.**
- With-held Rx's: Claims where a discount was applied to the prescription for the cardholder. **These are the claims that we're compensated on.** Occasionally a with-held claim may be reversed, which means that you won't get paid for that claim.

Step 3 – Claims reports will be provided in the back office.

Step 4 - Checks are made payable to the affiliate, as shown on the affiliate agreement, and are sent out by U.S. Mail, no later than forty-five (45) days following the end of the calendar month. Commission checks must total a minimum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) to be issued.
